ARRIVAL

Please follow the drop-off procedure located in our school handbook when dropping off your children. Enter East 199th St. (or any available side street) from Lake Shore Boulevard, proceed north to Edgecliff Dr. Turn right on Edgecliff and right again onto East 201st St. Make a right turn into the school parking lot and pull up as far as you can. Children should exit their cars from the right (passenger side) of the car.

Parents need to stay in their vehicles. **Preschool parents are permitted to park and walk the students into school.** Please have children ready to exit the car so you don't hold up the line. Walking your children to the door can cause delays for both the parents and the students. Thank you for your help with this.

MAP Testing Results

MAP Growth is a computer-adaptive test. Each test is different. If your child answers a question correctly, the next question is more challenging. If answered incorrectly, the next one is easier. MAP Growth allows for us to challenge our top performers and to help students that are below grade level. Our fall MAP session has ended. Results will be sent home with the students.

MAP uses a Ready for Instruction Today (RIT) score to measure what the students know. MAP Growth also allows us to see growth over time. Each time a student completes a test, the student is given a RIT score. This year we have started a new program called Edmentum, in which the students' RIT scores will be used to determine what objectives students need to work on. This program is web-based and can be worked on at home. Be sure to reach out to your child's teacher for more information on MAP scores and Edmentum.

MARCO'S PIZZA FUNDRAISER

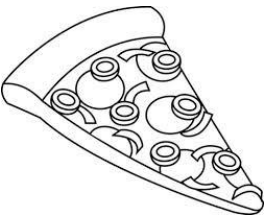
**UPDATE
