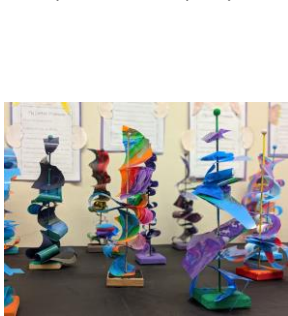

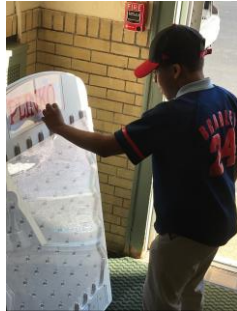
SCHOOL CALENDAR 2019-2020
