Math

Addition and subtraction math facts 1-10 are to be mastered. **You should be able to do them quickly and without using your fingers.** You are required to have addition and subtraction flash cards by the first day of school. **These will be sent back home with you for daily use.**

Reading

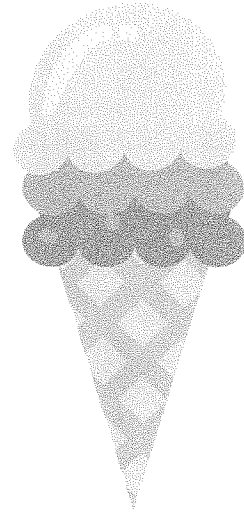
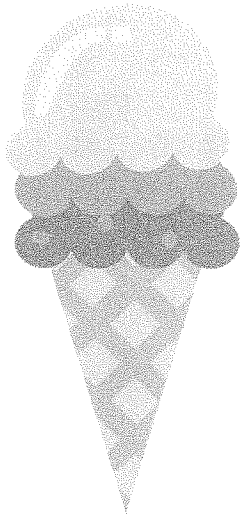
You should be reading every day, silently and orally. Read to someone who likes to listen to you and who can help you. Read whatever you like to read but READ! The libraries offer great reading clubs. Use your phonics skills and the context to figure out more difficult words. Practice reading with expression and talk about it with someone. Each time you read a book, complete the Ice Cream Cone form and have a parent sign it.

Writing

Daily writing is the best way to improve your writing skills. A journal is a great way to see your progress. **You should be able to write a complete sentence that begins with a capital letter and ends with a punctuation mark.** You should know how to write and spell your first and last name. **You should know how to spell basic sight words.**
